Requirements for Filing a Bankruptcy

In order to file a Bankruptcy, certain information must be provided to the court included in and in connection with your bankruptcy petition. Please be advised that:

All information that you are required to provide with your petition and thereafter in connection with your case **MUST** be complete, accurate, and truthful.

All assets and liabilities **MUST** be completely, accurately, and truthfully disclosed in the documents filed to commence your case. The replacement value of each asset **MUST** be stated in those documents where requested. A reasonable inquiry, by you, **MUST** be made to establish such value.

Your current monthly income and, for Chapter 13 cases, your disposable income, **MUST** be stated completely, accurately, and truthfully disclosed. A reasonable inquiry, by you, **MUST** be made to establish such amounts.

Information that you provide during your case may be audited pursuant to BAPCPA 11 USC §527(a)(2)(D), and failure to provide any information may result in **DISMISSAL** of your case or other sanctions, including but not limited to Civil and criminal sanction and penalties.

This notice has been provided to you within three (3) business days of your meeting with our firm as required by BAPCPA, 11 USC §527(a)(2).
